

Data protection notice

The use and sharing of personal data

Warnowquerung GmbH & Co. KG is pleased about your visit to our website as well as your interest in our company and our products. We take the protection of your personal data seriously and would like you to feel safe when you are visiting our Internet pages. We attach great importance to the protection of your privacy when processing personal data, which we take into account in our business processes. All private data generated will be processed and used in accordance with the German Data Protection Law. In general, we require your personal data to conclude a customer contract, to reply to your enquiries or to provide you with access to specific information or offers. We collect no personal data from our website without your explicit consent. Should it become necessary to collect such data, we will inform you and obtain your consent. Your personal information gathered in this way will not be given to third parties – except where we are obliged to do so on the basis of the statutory provisions – or used for any other purposes than those mentioned above.

We collect your private data only with your consent.

When you visit our web pages, our web servers routinely save the IP address, the web pages from which you are visiting us, the web pages you actually visit as well as the date and duration of your visit. Personal data is only stored when you willingly and openly give it to us, e.g. when registering in order to conclude a contract. The data will not be used for any other purpose, with the exception of statistics, and then only in such a way that ensures anonymity (i.e. an IP address that has been abbreviated to domain level). If you send us an e-mail, your e-mail address will only be used for the purpose of corresponding with you. Following the end of any correspondence, your e-mail address will be deleted. It will not be used in any other way or transferred to third parties.

Cookies

Warnowquerung GmbH & Co. KG does not use any cookies. Cookies may be used on linked sites without our being able to point this out to you. Most browsers are set in such a way that they accept cookies automatically. However, you can deactivate the storage of cookies or set your browser to inform you as soon as cookies are sent.

As a service provider, we are responsible for our own contents on these pages according to the general laws.
